Damage to Property & Mischief

Some young people have been caught throwing our erosion control rocks into the lake, as well as committing mischief such as using a knife to mutilate a large goldfish carp after catching it and slicing off the bark of the crepe myrtle tree by the red bridge. Attempts have been made to stop this behavior, but they have continued to come back near the red bridge. No Trespassing signs and signs warning against moving the rocks have been purchased and will be placed on the bridge side of the lake. If you see any of this type of activity, please report it immediately to the HOA emergency number (256-617-9600). Please use the HOA e-mail for non-emergencies.

Parking Issues

Please avoid long-term parking on the street. Street parking can cause safety and vehicle passage issues as well as reducing the beauty of our neighborhood. More importantly, it blocks the driver's view of children that may be playing close to the road. If more parking is needed and you are considering expanding your driveway, please contact the HOA with the plans. We are happy to assist with this to help prevent the congestion of street parking. Also, please be aware that boats, trailers, RVs, food trucks, and similar type vehicles may not be parked longer than 14 consecutive days on driveways; grass parking is prohibited.

Speeding

Speeding has become an increasing safety issue in the neighborhood. Please be aware of speed limits in the neighborhood, especially when on Saddle Ridge Drive where the speeding is mainly seen and the limit is 25 mph.

A Message from the SRHOA President

Lake News: Our beautiful lake is actually a retention pond that captures storm drain rain water and has unfortunately experienced damaging episodes of bank flooding caused by heavy torrential rainfall. Last year, these flooding episodes caused severe erosion and chunks of the banks to fall into the water which were already weakened by wildlife holes. After meeting with a representative from Huntsville city, it was recommended we purchase a rip-rap erosion prevention system. Veterans Lawncare did an excellent job creating the system that saved the banks and consisted of multiple days of re-shaping the banks, laying in an erosion liner and laying in many tons of rip rap rock along the higher 3 sides of the lake. The system has worked very well protecting the lake banks.

PLEASE BE CAREFUL AROUND THE LAKE!

Canadian geese, cranes, ducks, snapping turtles, snakes, fish & an occasional beaver or muskrat are some of the wildlife that live at and around our lake. Please be mindful of these precautions:

- Always keep a safe distance from all wildlife
- Be aware that snakes like the brushy side around the bridge
- Watch out for large animal holes & fire ant mounds
- Be sure to always supervise young children
- Please read the Lake Rules & Notice Sign posted in the gazebo
- Water is chemically treated <u>catch & release fishing</u> <u>only</u>

RESIDENT REMINDERS

Water Fountain

Please Note: fishing lines & plastic bags can kill the fountain motor. If you fish at the lake, please only fish on the gazebo (West) side, away from the fountain. Fishing line & plastic bags will tangle the underwater fountain apparatus and ruin the motor which would cost the neighborhood thousands of dollars to replace.

Property Maintenance

Please be sure to maintain the area behind the back of your fence to your property line. If the area behind your fence is within your property line, it is your responsibility to cut it and keep it free of trash. If the HOA has to hire someone to clean it up, the homeowner will be billed for the cost.

Annual Dues

Annual Dues are now \$190 per year

Annual dues are due on August 1st of every year & are overdue on August 15th.

Late fee schedule:

- \$20 late fee after Aug 15th
- Additional \$30 late fee after Jan 15th
- Additional \$30 late fee after June 15th
- Lien is filed after 1 year of delinquency.

Ways to Pay Your Annual Dues

We have explored different ways for homeowners to pay their annual dues. We have rejected using online 3rd party payments such as Venmo, Paypal, & Credit Cards due to issues with privacy rights, confidentiality, & data security. However, there are multiple ways to pay your annual dues:

- Personal check or money order
- Certified check from your bank or credit union
- Bill Pay check sent by your bank/credit union
 - · Simple to set up as an online banking option
 - Most of the time it's FREE
 - Can be set up as a recurring payment each year on August 1st.

Notification will be made by the HOA to residents of overgrown yards & a **\$10 per day fine** will be assessed if the yard continues to stay out of compliance after specified grace period.
